OFFICE ORDER

It is for the information of all the students of this institute that the grant of scholarship through various Central/state Schemes, UGC/AICTE Schemes is open on National Scholarship Portal (NSP). The **INTERESTED ELIGIBLE EXISTING AND FRESHER STUDENTS** are therefore advised to take immediate necessary steps to register themselves on the Portal: <https://scholarships.gov.in/>.

Brief guidelines/details of the Schemes are as under:-

PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR GIRL STUDENTS (TECHNICAL DIPLOMA)

OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME:-

Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing assistance for advancement of Girls pursuing technical education. Education is one of the most important means of empowering women with the knowledge, skill and self-confidence necessary to participate fully in the development process. This is an attempt to give young women the opportunity to further her education and prepare for a successful future by "Empowering Women through Technical Education".

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:-

- 1) The girl candidate should be admitted to First year of Diploma level course OR Second year of Diploma level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year.
- 2) Maximum two girls child per family are eligible.
- 3) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by State/ UT Government need to be enclosed.

MODE OF PAYMENT:-

After selection, the awardees will be paid scholarship through DBT mode on annual basis.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:-

- 1) The candidate fulfilling the eligibility conditions is required to apply online on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) after initiation of application process and notice to be published on AICTE website.
- 2) The host institution where the candidate is studying, required to verify the online application.
- 3) Department of Technical Education (DTE) of respective State/ UT will verify these applications as second level of scrutiny.

CRITERIA OF SELECTION:-

- 1) The selection of candidate will be carried out solely on the basis of merit of qualifying examination to peruse the Technical Diploma course from any of the AICTE approved institutions

- i.e. in First year or Second year (through lateral entry only) on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in the 10th/ equivalent examination.
- 2) State/ UT wise merit list will be prepared as per number of scholarships allotted in the point number 3.0 above.

SAKSHAM SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR SPECIALLY ABLED STUDENT (TECHNICAL DIPLOMA)

OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME:-
Saksham is a MHRD Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing encouragement and support to specially-abled children to pursue technical education. This is an attempt to give every young student, who is otherwise specially-abled, the opportunity to study further and prepare for a successful future through technical education/knowledge.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP:-

- 1) The candidate should be admitted to First year of Diploma level course OR Second year of Diploma level course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year.
- 2) Specially-abled student, having disability of not less than 40%.
- 3) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by State/UT Government need to be enclosed.

MODE OF PAYMENT:-

After selection, the awardee will be paid scholarship through DBT mode on annual basis.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:-

- 1) The candidate fulfilling the eligibility conditions is required to apply online on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) after initiation of application process and notice to be published on AICTE website.
- 2) The host institution where the candidate is studying, required to verify the online application.
- 3) Department of Technical Education (DTE) of respective State/ UT will verify these applications as second level of scrutiny.

3. POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIPS SCHEME FOR MINORITIES

OBJECTIVE:-

The objective of the scheme is to award scholarships to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority community so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education, increase their rate of attainment in higher education and enhance their employability.

SCOPE:-

The scholarship is to be awarded for studies in India in a government or private higher secondary school/college/university, including such residential institutes of the Government and eligible private institutes selected and notified in a transparent manner by the State Government/Union Territory Administration concerned. It will also cover technical and vocational courses in Industrial Training Institutes/ Industrial Training Centres affiliated with the National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) of classes XI and XII level including Polytechnics and other courses (any course of less than one year duration is not covered under this scheme; Certificate courses are also not covered).

ELIGIBILITY:-

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh.

MODE OF APPLYING:-

The scheme is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in.

INSTRUCTIONS RELATED TO BANK ACCOUNT DETAILS (to be filled by the students in online application form are as under)-:

- (i) Students must select their bank/branch name carefully from the drop down list.
- (ii) Thereafter the complete account no. must be entered correctly. Students are suggested to get their account number verified by their concerned Bank Branch including Bank account number and IFS Code.
- (iii) Disclaimer (*If bank details entered by students are found incorrect or not validated by the student's bank, the scholarship will be canceled/amount will not be transferred even though the application is approved for scholarship).
- (iv) Bank Account holders must check their 'Know your Customer' (KYC) status from bank and if required the KYC must be done for successful transaction of scholarship amount.
- (v) Bank Account must be operational/active till the scholarship is disbursed.
- (vi) Bank Account must be preferably in any scheduled Bank with core banking facility and proper IFS Code.
- (vii) Bank Account must be in the name of the student/applicant only.

4. POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

OBJECTIVE:-

- (a) To support student with disabilities to study further in order to prepare themselves to earn their livelihood and to find a dignified place for themselves in the society as they face several barriers physical, financial, psychological, mental in pursuing studies and living with dignity. At times such students are deprived of harnessing their latent skills and thereby miss the opportunity.
- (b) To support students with disabilities for their studies in class XI and XII onwards so that the incidence of drop out, especially in the transition from the secondary to the higher secondary stage is minimized.
- (c) To improve participation of students with disabilities in class XI and XII and at the post-metric stage of education.
- (d) All Graduate Degree & Post-graduate Degree/Diploma courses recognized by UGC/AICTE shall be covered under Post-matric Scholarship.

SCOPE:-

Scholarships under this scheme shall be available for studying in classes XI,XII, Post-matriculation diploma/certificates and Bachelor's Degree or Diploma in India and Master's Degree/Diploma from any University recognized by UGC/AICTE.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:-

- (i) These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized institutions with the following exceptions:
"Scholarships are not awarded for training courses like Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Courses and Private Pilot License Courses. Courses at Training – Ship Dufferin (Now Rajendra), Centres of all India and State Levels."
- (ii) Only those candidates who have passed the Matriculation or Higher Secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible.
- (iii) Courses at the level of post-graduate degree/diploma/certificate are also covered under this scheme.

- (iv) Candidates who after passing one stage of education are studying in the same stage of education in different subject e.g. B. Com. After B.A. in other subject will not be eligible. However, students pursuing L.L.B./B.Ed/B.Ed/B.E. etc. are eligible for Post-Matric Scholarship under this scheme.
- (v) Students who are pursuing two different courses of study simultaneously can avail the scholarship for any one course only provided pursuance of such courses are permissible under the rules/regulations of the Educational Authority concerned.
- (vi) Students studying in Class XI of Higher Secondary School courses of the XII Class of the Multipurpose High School will not be eligible for it being a continuous school course. However, in cases where Xth class examination of such courses is treated as equivalent to Matriculation and students who after passing Xth class join other courses, such students will be treated as post-matric students and will be eligible for the award of scholarships.
- (vii) Students who after failing or passing the undergraduate examinations in Arts/Science/Commerce join any recognized professional or Technical certificate/diploma/degree courses will be awarded scholarships if otherwise eligible. No subsequent failure will be condoned except courses in Group-I.
- (viii) Students who pursue their studies through correspondence courses are also eligible. The term correspondence includes distant and continuing education.
- (ix) Employed students whose income combined with the income of their parents/guardians does not exceed the maximum prescribed income ceiling are made eligible to post-matric scholarships to the extent of reimbursement of all compulsorily payable non-refundable fees.

MODE OF APPLYING:-

The scheme is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP).

MODE OF DISBURSAL OF SCHOLARSHIP:-

The scholarship scheme shall be implemented through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) and the amount will be directly credited into the bank account of the beneficiaries through PFMS system by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities. It is for the information of all the students of this institute that the grant of scholarship through various Centrally Sponsored State (Himachal Pradesh) Schemes is open on National Scholarship Portal (NSP). The **INTERESTED ELIGIBLE EXISTING AND FRESHER STUDENTS** are therefore advised to take immediate necessary steps to register themselves on the portal: <https://scholarships.gov.in/>.

1. Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the Schemes are as under:-

Eligibility Conditions:-

- (i) The scholarships are open to nationals of India.
- (ii) These scholarships will be given for study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized Institutions/Universities/Colleges, where PMS-

SC can be availed for intermediate, graduate, post-graduate courses and include the following:

- a. Institutions of national importance;
 - b. Central university/ State university/Autonomous colleges recognized by UGC and Universities/Colleges recognized under section 2(f) and 12(b) of UGC Act;
 - c. Deemed universities
 - d. Private Universities recognized by State/Centre with 'A' level or equivalent accreditation by NAAC,NBA;
 - e. Private professional institutions affiliated to a recognized Central/State University and covered by Fee fixation committee as mandated by Supreme Court;
 - f. Recognized schools/colleges for Classes XI and class XII;
 - g. Diploma granting Institutions as recognized by State/UT Governments;
- The scholarship will be paid to the students whose parents/guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two lacs fifty thousand only)
- 2. Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for ST Students:-**
- (i) The scholarships are open to nationals of India.
 - (ii) These scholarships will be given for study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized Institutions with the following exceptions:

"Scholarships are not awarded for training courses like Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Courses and Private Pilot License courses at Training –Ship Dufferin (Now Rajendra),

courses of training at the Military College, Dehradun and courses at pre-examination training centres of all India and State levels"

- (iii) Only those candidates who belong to Schedule Tribes so specified in relation to the State/Union Territory to which the applicant actually belongs i.e. permanently settled) and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher Secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible.
- (vi) Students studying in Class XI of Higher Secondary Schools which have a continuous school courses of 12th class will not be eligible. However, in cases where the Xth class examination of such courses is treated as equivalent to Matriculation and students after passing tenth class can join other courses such students will be treated as post-matric students and will be eligible for the award of scholarship.
- (vii) The scholarship will be paid to the students whose parents/guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees Two lacs fifty thousand only).

3. Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for OBC Eligibility Conditions:-

- (i) The scholarships will be open to Indian nationals belonging to OBC's as notified by the Central Govt./State Govt./UT Admn;
- (ii) These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized post-matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in recognized institutions as specified in para IV(i).
- (iii) Only those candidates who belong to OBC's so specified in relation to the State/UT to which the applicant actually belongs i.e. permanently settled and who have passed the Matriculation or Higher secondary or any higher examination of a recognized University or Board of Secondary Education will be eligible.
- (vi) Students studying in XI Class of the Higher Secondary School courses or the XII class of the Multipurpose High School will not be eligible for it being a continuous school course. However, in cases where tenth class examination of such courses is treated as equivalent to Matriculation and students who after passing tenth class join other courses, such students will be treated as post-matric students and will be eligible for the award of scholarships.
- (x) Scholarships should be restricted upto two boys of the same parents/guardian. This restriction will, however not apply to girls.
- (xiii) Employed students whose income combined with the income of their parents/guardians does not exceed Rs. 1.50 lakh per annum shall be eligible for post-matric scholarship to the extent of reimbursement of all compulsorily payable non-refundable fee.
- (xiv) Unemployed students whose parents/guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 1.50 lakh per annum will be entitled for the scholarship under the Scheme.

4. Dr. Ambedkar medhavi Chhatrvriti Yojna for OBC Students Eligibility Conditions:-

- (i) This scholarship will be given to top 1000 meritorious students of Scheduled Caste category and top 1000 meritorious students of Other Backward Classes declared as such in the result of Matric Examination conducted by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala strictly on merit basis for +1 and +2 classes in a recognized institution within or outside the state. The renewal in +2 class will be subject to satisfactory performance in 10+1 internal examination.
- (ii) The Scholarship will also be given in case the eligible student takes admission in any professional/technical course after Matric, in a recognized institution within or

outside the State. However it will be limited for maximum of two successive years after matric. The renewal in 2nd year of the course will be subject to satisfactory performance in 1st year of the course.

(iii) The eligible Students must belong to Scheduled caste and Other Backward Classes Category declared as such by the H.P. Government from time to time.

5. Dr. Ambedkar medhavi Chhatravriti Yoina for SC Student

Eligibility Conditions:-

- (i) This scholarship will be given to top 1250 meritorious students of Scheduled Caste category and top 1000 meritorious students of Other Backward Classes declared as such in the result of Matric Examination conducted by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala strictly on merit basis for +1 and +2 classes in a recognized institution within or outside the state. The renewal in +2 class will be subject to satisfactory performance in 10+1 internal examination.
- (ii) The Scholarship will also be given in case the eligible student takes admission in any professional/technical course after Matric, in a recognized institution within or outside the State. However it will be limited for maximum of two successive years after matric. The renewal in 2nd year of the course will be subject to satisfactory performance in 1st year of the course.
- (iv) The eligible Students must belong to Scheduled caste and Other Backward Classes Category declared as such by the H.P. Government from time to time.

6. Dr. Ambedkar Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for Economically Backward Classes

Eligibility Conditions:-

- (i) The scholarships will be open to Indian nationals belonging to General Category (Other than Schedule Caste, Schedule Tribe and Other Backward Classes) and the total income from all sources of the employed candidate or his/her parents/guardians in case of unemployed candidate shall not exceed Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum.
- (ii) Income certificate should be submitted from the competent authority in the State/Union Territory.
- (iii) These scholarships will be given for the study of all recognized post matriculation or post-secondary courses pursued in the Government institutions only with the following exceptions:
 - "Scholarships shall not be awarded for Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL) Course and other aviation linked courses."
 - (iv) Students studying in XI Class of the Higher Secondary School courses or the XII class of the Multipurpose High School will not be eligible for it being a continuous school course. However, in cases, where tenth class examination of such courses is treated as equivalent to Matriculation and students who after passing tenth class join other

courses, such students will be treated as post-matric students and will be eligible for the award of scholarships.

(v) Only two boys of the same parents/guardian will be entitled to receive scholarships. Girls of same parents/guardian will not apply to girls. Accordingly, scholarship availed by scholarship upto two boys of same parents/guardian will not adversely affect admissibility of availling

(xiii) Employed students whose income combined with the income of their

parents/guardians does not exceed Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum shall be eligible for post-matric scholarships to the extent of reimbursement of all compulsorily payable non-refundable fees.

(xiv) In case of unemployed students whose parents/guardians income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 1.00 lakh per annum will be entitled for the scholarship under the Scheme.

7. Indira Gandhi Utkrisht Chhatravriti Yojna

Eligibility Conditions:-

The scholarship will be awarded to 10 Toppers each from the merit list of 10+2 Arts, Science & Commerce supplied by HP Board of School Education, Dharamshala

provided they join any academic/professional stream.

8. IRDP

Eligibility Conditions:-

For students belonging to BPL families.

9. Kalpana Chawla Chhatravriti Yojna

Eligibility Conditions:-

(i) This scholarship will be awarded each year to top 2000 meritorious Girl students of all study groups i.e. Science, Arts and Commerce streams based on passing ratio in each group as per the merit list supplied by the H.P. Board of School Education, Dharamshala for post 10+2 courses, after Examination conducted by the H.P. Board of School Education.

(ii) The aforesaid Scholarship will be awarded to the Girl students who take admission as a regular student in any recognized post 10+2, academic, professional or technical course from any Govt. aided or recognized private institution for its full term subject to satisfactory performance each year.

(iv) The scholarship will be renewed and carried on till they complete degree/diploma/certificate course provided there is no failure, in which case the scholarship shall cease to continue.

10. Mahirish Balmiki Chhatravriti Yojna

Eligibility Conditions:-

(i) This scholarship will be awarded to all the girl students belonging to Balmiki families, beyond Matric upto College level and professional courses at the level of college situated in H.P.

(ii) The candidate should produce a certificate from the competent authority of Himachal Pradesh for belonging to Balmiki families engaged in

The certificate in respect of working in "Unclean occupation" may be obtained from Head of office where the parents are working.

11. Swami Vivekanand Uttkrisht Chattarvriti Yojna

Eligibility Conditions:-

- (i) This scholarship will be given to top 2000 meritorious students of General Category declared as such in the result of Matric Examination conducted by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala strictly on merit basis for +1 and +2 classes in a recognized institution with in or outside the state. The renewal in +2 class will be subject to satisfactory performance in 10+1 internal examination.
- (ii) The Scholarship will also be given in case the eligible student takes admission in any professional/technical course after Matric, in a recognized institution within or outside the State. However it will be limited for maximum of two successive years after matric. The renewal in 2nd year of the course will be subject to satisfactory performance in 1st year of the course.
- (iii) The eligible student must belong to General Category.

12. Thakur Sen Negi Uttkrisht Chhattervriti Yojna

Eligibility Conditions:-

- (i) This scholarship will be given to top 100 Girls and top 100 Boys students belonging to the Tribal Community of H.P., declared as such in the result of Matric Examination conducted by H.P. Board of School Education Dharamshala strictly on merit basis for +1 and +2 classes in a recognized institution within or outside the state. The renewal in +2 class will be subject to satisfactory performance in 10+1 internal examination.
- (ii) The Scholarship will also be given in case the eligible student takes admission in any professional/technical course after Matric, in a recognized institution within or outside the State. However it will be limited for maximum of two years after matric. The renewal in 2nd year of the course will be subject to satisfactory performance in 1st year of the course.
- (iii) The eligible student must belong to Scheduled Tribes of H.P. as declared by H.P. Government from time to time.
